Generation of an Active Meeting

During a meeting or convention, the communication between the participants and the presenter and between the participants themselves is very important.

In many discussions it is important to record a protocol, write personal comments, share files and pass questions via chat to the presenter. In technical meetings there is often a need to share graphic information between the participants.

Streamitup Active Meeting enables the participants, both those present in the room, as well as the distant participants, to take part in the discussion in a number of ways: Textual chat with the other participants and with the presenter, noting comments and sharing them, as well as by active participation via the virtual whiteboard.

Continuation of the Discussion after the Meeting Is based on saving the content presented by the presenter, including video, audio and presentations, which are automatically attributed to the selected

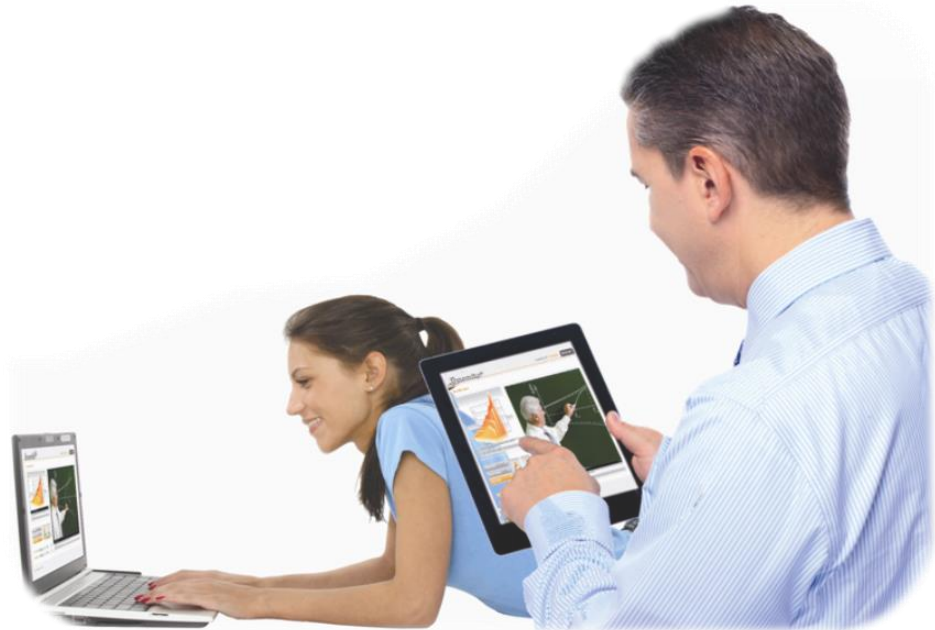
Content Channel. Moreover, it is of great importance to save the participants' comments, in a synchronous manner.

These comments can be the protocol of the meeting or a list of tasks for implementation that each participant noted for himself or important points for the next discussion.

All the personal and shared comments are saved in the Organizational Database. At every stage – even after the conclusion of the discussion it is possible to add or edit these comments.

All these comments are included in the search mechanism enabling immediate access to the precise point in time that the comment was noted.

- During a meeting, lesson or training session, the presenter often utilizes visual aids and diagrams, which could constitute the basis for the discussion.
- The presenter and all other participants connect to their personal accounts from any device.
- All participants- both those who are present in the room, and distant participants can see the shared graphics and can add their comments to the discussion graphically.
- During the meeting each of the participants can immediately share a picture or diagram with the other participants by simply dragging it to the joint area.
- The picture will appear as a background to the joint virtual whiteboard and will constitute a graphic basis for the discussion
- It is possible to write on and draw diagrams on the picture, as well as to change it at any stage without losing existing data.
- In addition to the graphic sharing capabilities, each participant can save a copy of the diagram locally as an image for later use.
- Beyond the graphic capabilities, files can be immediately transferred to all members of the group at the push of a button.
- Each participant can draw or erase and edit the joint diagram, as though all were standing at the same white board in the same conference room.



These capabilities can also be integrated for:

- ✓ Meetings that have an audience of distant participants as well as for recorded meetings in which all participants are in the same room, but the intention is to enable interaction during the meeting.
- ✓ Streamitup Active Meeting can be combined with any of Streamitup's recording and live broadcast solutions.
